

Goal:

Get some hands-on experience in using the Internet to find (or not find) information. **Have fun.** Don't spend more than an hour if it's not working out.

Assignment:

1. If you don't already have it, obtain *Internet Access* for yourself. One way to do this is via the Office of Academic Computing on the fourth floor of the Math-Science building. It is a free service for students, takes five minutes, and will be good until you graduate. Bring your ID & Reg card.
2. For 45 minutes, Use *any* of the Internet Information-Retrieval tools demonstrated in the GSLIS 110 lecture on May 3 or that are listed below. If you want to work with something else, check with Professor Botello first. *Have some fun with this!*
3. Use electronic mail to send Keri Botello an e-mail message (about 2 screens worth) letting her know what Internetworked software you tried, how you liked it, and whether you might use it for a past, present, or future project. Unless you've finished setting up the e-mail software, 'put your name on your paper.'
